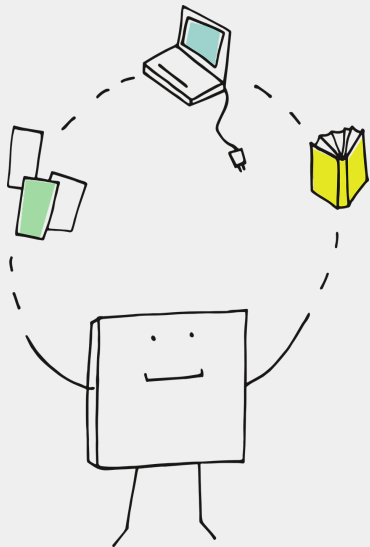

The Virtual Classroom

How to Sign Up for Online Virtual Classroom

- Registration Code: *Given at registration
- If you have not created a TakingITGlobal account, you will be prompted to do it at this point. Once it is created, you will be connected to the Virtual Classroom.
- After joining the classroom you can visit <http://encounters.tiged.org/> anytime for easy access to all your classes (listed under "My Classes" on the homepage).
